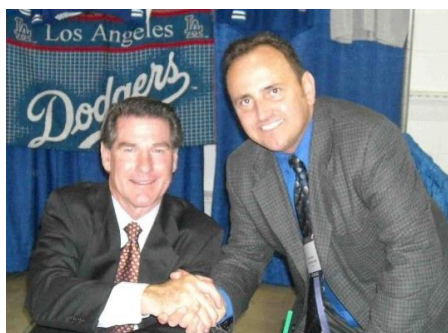

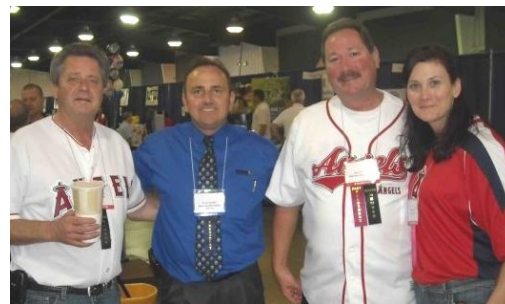
WHAT A SHOW!!!

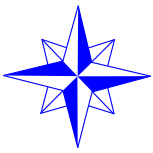
